Steps to follow

#1 - End of production sequence

If necessary, remove designated elements manually

#2 - Air purge

Release air through the pressure valve and make sure that air pressure accumulator is relieved if equipped.

#3 - Cleaning of the machine

Make sure to clean the product line from any residual elements:

- Purge air line
- Clean filters
- Remove all dirt and Foreign Object from the equipment.

#4 - Preventive maintenance

Follow your company preventive maintenance program or use the operation and maintenance manual from your partners.

Fill up spare parts and components' list.

#5 - Environmental

Make sure that your equipment is in a stable environment, control temperature, humidity, and cleanliness.

Ventilation needs to be checked every week to be sure that there is no moisture or humidity.

If approved by the engineering department proceed to WD40 spray on certain elements.

#6 - Protection

Put all protection devices in place to avoid any unintional start.

Use a protection for your entire equipment.

#7 - Electricity

Make a backup of all your machines: PLC ► HMI Robots Replace the batteries following the manufacturer's

recommendations.

Control that breakers are open and secure.

#8 - Get support

Call external support for your product line manufacturer.
